Quill is a platform for web applications that teaches writing, grammar, and vocabulary skills to K-12 students. It creates strong, effective authors by providing students with instant feedback and personalized activities. Teachers save time grading homework and can easily generate differentiated learning paths. Administrators and teachers can use Quill Progress Reports to ascertain students' mastery of the Common Core standards. This powerful tool is free to anyone with an internet connection.

Quill currently features three apps: Quill Grammar, Quill Proofreader, and Quill Writer. In the coming year, we will introduce apps that teach vocabulary, peer feedback, and expository writing. Quill is a nonprofit, open source community, and more than 100 educators and developers have contributed to it. Our long-term vision is to collaboratively build a series of educational apps. Together, we can engage students in every aspect of the writing process and empower them to write their own stories.

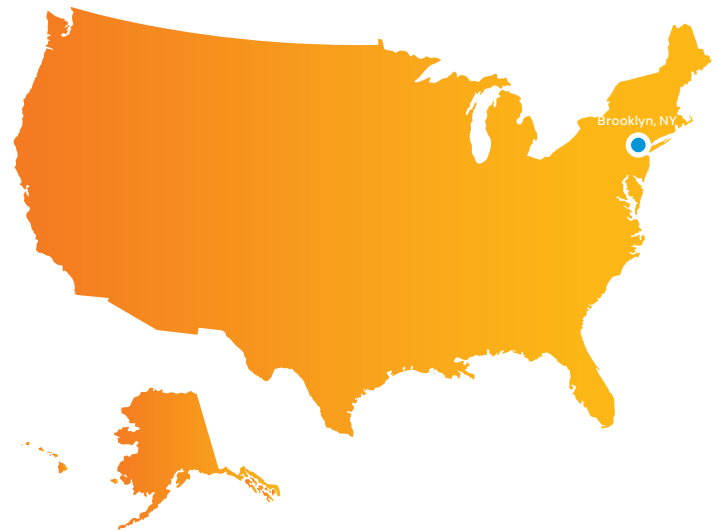
